Awards and Point System

Ribbons 1st to 6th place

High Point and Reserve High Point for Senior, Intermediate, Junior, Novice, Walk-Trot/Jog 18 and under and Walk-Trot/Jog Green Horse 19+

Lead line not eligible for yearend awards

Points to be accumulated towards year end Trophies for each division. Ten Volunteer hours and two meetings must be completed and attended to qualify. Family members may complete Volunteer hours.

Horse and Rider must compete in at least two shows to be eligible for yearend awards. For example; two jumping shows, or two English Hack, two Western Games etc.

Best Turned out Horse and Rider Ribbon and Prize (value \$25) for each day of the Show. In the case of Western Performance and Western Games; one for each discipline will be awarded.

No cross entries with Walk/Trot (jog), Lead line or Novice Divisions. For example a horse and rider may not jump and then enter walk/trot in the Flat Classes. Or enter an age division for one discipline and walk/trot (jog) for another discipline.

Attire

We reserve the right to refuse admittance to any horse or rider that is not suitably attired; or horse of good condition and soundness.

ASTM Helmets are mandatory for all English Riders and any Western Rider 18 and under. For Western Riders 19 and over please sign the attached waiver if choosing to not wear protective head gear. You will not be penalised for wearing a helmet. Proper riding boots are mandatory for both English and Western Riders. Clean, neat and tidy workmanlike attire is acceptable. In the event of a tie, show attire may result in a tie breaker at the discretion of the judge.

For the welfare of the horse, please take note of the following;

Maximum of six Jumping rounds per horse. With a maximum of five counting for highpoint, highest point score will be used.

Maximum of ten under saddle classes per day per horse. Best five point accumulations to be used toward discipline daily High Points and Year End Awards.

Riders sharing horses is permitted but riders must abide by class maximums allowed for horse's use

Any inhumane treatment or abuse of the horse by any person is forbidden. The judge and/or show management have the authority to disqualify the exhibitor, owner or agent from the class or event.

No coaching from the sidelines unless permitted by the Judge

No rider is to be mounted or showing until All Entry Fees and Waivers are paid and signed. No exceptions!

It is mandatory that all exhibitors hold a current HCBC membership.
